2 Timothy 3:1-6 KJV

3 This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come. ²For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, ³Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good, ⁴Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God; ⁵Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away. ⁶For of this sort are they which creep into houses, and lead captive silly women laden with sins, led away with divers lusts,

¿What is Holiness?

Psalm 29:2 KJV

²Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name; worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness.

The word “holy” is the Greek word *hagios* which means to be separated, set apart, consecrated and holy for the exclusive use of God. It is a state of being pure, clean and innocent; it is the essence of who God is, He is the holy one.

The purpose of holiness

1. To prevent contamination – Genesis 1:4
2. To be the remnant bride – 1 Thessalonians 5:23
3. To possess his inheritance – Act 20:32

Exodus 19:9-11 KJV

⁹And the LORD said unto Moses, Lo, I come unto thee in a thick cloud, that the people may hear when I speak with thee, and believe thee for ever. And Moses told the words of the people unto the LORD. ¹⁰And the LORD said unto Moses, Go unto the people, and sanctify them to day and to morrow, and let them wash their clothes, ¹¹And be ready against the third day: for the third day the LORD will come down in the sight of all the people upon mount Sinai.

Hebrews 12:14 KJV

¹⁴Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord:

Holiness is spiritual hygiene.

Another word for holiness is integrity.

¿What is Integrity?

Titus 2:7 KJV

7In all things shewing thyself a pattern of good works: in doctrine shewing uncorruptness, gravity, sincerity,

The word “Integrity” means to be holy, to be one with yourself, with your words and actions. A whole person is someone pure, without mixture, without corruption, of a single mind; He is not divided, he is someone complete.

¿For whom are we separated?

1. God separates us for Him – Exodus 19:4-6
2. God sets us apart for a calling and purpose – Acts 13:2 and 2 Timothy 1:9

2. The word – Eph. 5:26, Matthew 4:4
3. The fire of the Holy Spirit – 1 Cor. 14:5, Mal. 3:2-3
